





Equipment: Two blindfolds

Restrictions: None

Preparation: Find an area where there is enough space to create a large circle.

How to play: Organise the group into a large circle. Nominate 2 children to be bats and 4 children to be moths. The bats should wear the blindfolds. Once the blindfold has been put on, the moths should begin to shout 'Moth' continuously! The bats should use their hearing to locate the moths. Once captured the moths should leave the circle. Repeat the game until everybody has had a go at being either a bat or a moth.

- Bat cookie cutters
- Rolling pins
- Paint

Instructions:

- Cover tables and pupils put on aprons to protect clothing
- Each pupil given a piece of air dry clay on a slate

- Leave to dry overnight
